#### MINUTES OF MEETING NO 2 OF THE HIGHWAYS JOINT MEMBER PANEL

#### 1. APOLOGIES REPLACEMENT MEMBERSHIP

Apologies were received from Councillor Crawley.

#### 2. MINUTES

The Minutes of the Panel meeting held on 26 July were confirmed. In consideration of the Minutes, it was reported that the petition concerning Westfield Road, Harpenden, had been withdrawn. It was also reported that the consultation on the Leyton Road, Harpenden 20 mph zones had not been completed,

#### **AGREED**

That the decision made in Minute No 8 of the previous meeting be confirmed allowing the Chairman, Vice – Chairman and Local County Councillor T Heritage to consider any formal objections that might be received arising from the Leyton Road 20 mph zone consultation.

# 3. FUTURE CHANGE FROM HIGHWAYS JOINT MEMBER PANELS (HJMPS) TO HIGHWAY LIAISON MEETINGS (HLMS)

The Panel received a report on the potential successor arrangements to Highways Joint Member Panels following re-organisation which took place on 1 October. The County Council was seeking to hold Highways Liaison Meetings (HLMs) in place of the Panels. A meeting had taken place with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Panel and County Council representatives in August. It was intended that County Council members and officers would attend a full meeting of the District Council where the 2001 Agreement might be ended. As yet, the required one year's notice to terminate the Agreement had not been given.

In answer to questions about future representation and scrutiny, it was ascertained that clarity was needed.

In explaining the highways officers' new roles, Danny Kyan referred to new ways of service delivery via two designated teams. Minor repairs and routine works would be dealt with by Ringway who would be providing District Service Agents (DSAs) and Local Network Technicians (LNTs). These officers would support County members, stakeholders and the public. A member was keen that these officers be provided with lists of the issues outstanding from the JMP. Members also asked about when these posts would be established and when members would be notified. Danny Kyan stated that Ringway was in the process of making appointments and was asked to circulate the information when it became available.

The report was noted.

#### **ACTION**

Danny Kyan to inform Panel members of staffing arrangements.

#### 4. **NEW PETITIONS**

In accordance with the Highway Locality Budget Scheme, new petitions would be directly referred to the relevant County Councillor. There had been no new petitions in the next quarter.

#### 5. ACTION TRACKER

Members were asked to note the action tracker and comments were invited.

Danny Kyan highlighted that the proposal for a shared cycle route on the A414 between Napsbury and Park Street did not rank highly enough to warrant funding. However, County Councillors had been approached about contributions from their locality budgets for a scoping report.

The report was noted.

#### 6. **PETITION STATUS REPORT**

Members were asked to note this report. Danny Kyan reported that the additional surfacing works to Alexander Road, London Colney had been undertaken the previous day. He also undertook to inform Councillors about new petitions being shown on the Highways website.

#### **ACTION**

Danny Kyan to pursue the availability of petitions on the website and update members.

#### 7. ST ALBANS TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT - HOLYWELL HILL

Danny Kyan set out the options under consideration following a modelling exercise. These included:

 Closure of Victoria Street from The Maltings Car Park to Chequer Street to all vehicles except buses

- Improvements to key junctions into the City
- Potential traffic gating/queue relocation options at a signalled King Harry Junction
- Potential traffic gating/queue relocation options through signalisation of the Holywell Hill/Griffiths Way junction

Officers proposed to undertake feasibility work on these options. Councillors expressed concern that local County Councillors had not yet been consulted. One asked that in further work be done on this option. Overall, Panel members were not in favour of the closure of Victoria Street to all vehicles. Danny Kyan also flagged up proposed improvements to the Batchwood Roundabout and the Ancient Briton Junction. Funding could be available from the Local Sustainable Transport Fund (LSTF) to address air pollution in the City Centre Peahen Junction.

Councillors expressed the view that buses were responsible for contributing to high pollution levels and Councillor Read, the District Council Portfolio Holder for Community Engagement and Localism referred to the possibility of splitting the queuing at Griffiths Way. This could reduce congestion by altering traffic light phasing. County Councillors again expressed their concern that they had not been consulted on the proposals.

#### **ACTION**

Danny Kyan to convey to Rupert Thacker, Programmes and Strategy Manager that:

- The Panel was opposed to the closure of Victoria Street.
- Consultation must take place with all relevant County Councillors.
- That the proposals were generally welcome and should be taken forward subject to consultation.

#### 8. LEYTON ROAD 20 MPH ZONE - REPORTING OBJECTION(S)

As Highways officers had not yet finalised the formal consultation, there was no report available for the meeting.

#### 9. DEVELOPMENT OF VERGE DAMAGE ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE

The Verge Management Joint Working Sub Group had met seven times to consider verge parking enforcement. The Group had succeeded in introducing licences to enable storage of building materials at suitable locations. This requirement was set out in every successful planning application as an informative note.

The Chairman referred to some success, particularly in the Sopwell ward. He urged Councillors to encourage the reporting of verge damage as it occurred. Councillors agreed that the main causes of damage were from parking and building works. The consensus was that verge parking be monitored and that enforcement methods be strengthened. Councillors felt that it would be useful for planning decision notices to be sent to applicants as well as the agents acting for them.

Councillor Gordon asked about the scheme enforcing no verge parking in Colney Heath and whether it was feasible to extend this to London Colney. Danny Kyan stated that this was still under consideration although the verges in London Colney were not mapped.

#### **ACTION**

Steve Deakin, Specialist Environmental Compliance Officer be asked to investigated the possibility of a blanket verge parking ban in London Colney.

# 5. <u>Future Change from Highways Joint Member Panels (HJMPs) To Highway Liaison Meetings (HLMs)</u>

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To advise of successor arrangements to HJMPs and the process for their introduction.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND

Members of our two authorities have been meeting as a Highways Joint Member Panel under the agreement between our councils dated 30 May 2001. As members are aware, the County Council intends to change from HJMPs to HLMS. The purpose of the HLMs is to a) widen the engagement with all district members and b), better reflect the more involved role of county members in this important County Council service.

With the introduction of Highway Locality Budgets across the county in 2012/13, local highway constituency matters are dealt with by the local county councillor, with increased engagement with local communities and representatives, including district, borough, town and parish councillors. This has prompted a review and proposed change to the format, role and oversight of the Service by HJMPs to bi – annual HLMs.

#### 3.0 PROCESS FOR DECISION

Members will be aware that the County's highways function has recently been reorganised and the new Highways Service structure became operational on 1 October 2012. This structure has been designed to support the HLM process.

The County Council is seeking an alternative, but consistent model or framework, to the HJMP for engagement on district wide and strategic matters, particularly with district, borough and other local elected members, using the HLM model as the framework which can be developed to become a useful forum to enable local elected representatives to work together.

Members will note that a report about these changes was presented to the HCC Highways and Transport Panel on Tuesday 3 July 2012 and its recommendations reported to The HCC Cabinet for endorsement on 16 July 2012.

The county council will continue to engage with all district and borough councils through HLMs which it hopes will provide a useful forum for future member involvement. Full details of the liaison meetings are now being finalised.

The meeting of the St Albans Highways Joint Member Panel to be held on 10 January 2013 can enable any remaining business to be concluded. Following that, officers and members from the County Council would discuss the proposal to cease the HJMP and to establish the HLM arrangement. At that stage, it is hoped that the 2001 agreement to hold HJMPs can be terminated.

#### 9. ST ALBANS AREA HLB AND STREET CLEAN PROGRAMMES - 2012/13

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To inform Panel Members of the latest information regarding, the 2012/13 Highway Locality Budgets (HLB) Programmes, and the planned joint working street clean arrangements.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

HCC's Highway Locality Budgets scheme has been successfully introduced at April 2012 to all county divisions.

With the introduction of the HLB arrangements, local highway constituency matters are dealt with by the county councillor, with increased engagement with local communities and representatives, including district, borough, town and parish councillors.

#### 3. SCHEDULE

The 2012/13 Members' Highway Locality Budgets (HLB) Scheme, provides a £6.9 million county wide fund, and represents an appropriate percentage of the total highways maintenance budget for 2012/13 shown in the following table.
