## ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF CYCLEPATH CONSTRUCTION WORKS

**Cyclepath construction works are due to commence on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> September 2015 which are programmed to take approximately 2 days to complete, weather permitting.**

The works in this area are part of the St Albans Green Ring project which has been developed by the County Council in partnership with St Albans City and District Council. The aim is to create a circular route around St Albans to increase use and enjoyment of the city's green space and to make cycling and walking a sensible first choice for journeys within the city.

The works on **Lemsford Road** will be undertaken between **9.30am and 15.00pm**, Monday to Friday, weather permitting.

However, if we encounter unforeseen circumstances on site, it is possible we may work outside these hours. We will aim to complete the noisiest operations such as removing the old road and jack hammering by midnight to reduce the disturbance to nearby residential properties. Other works will still continue after this.

**Given the nature of these works, which are heavily weather dependant there may be occasions where the dates we have indicated may change. However, we will endeavour to keep to the programme throughout the delivery of this scheme.**
