**Consultation – Clarence Park, Car Park Tariffs**

Following the Clarence Park Consultative Forum meeting on 12 November 2015 it was agreed to carry out a consultation on proposed changes to the parking tariffs for Clarence Park. The Forum heard representations from members that the Clarence Park Car Park was being used for all day parking by commuters and space for users of the park was difficult to find. The proposed changes will deter long stay parking by commuters and allow short term parking for park users.

The table below shows the proposed changes:



Please note the car park closes at dusk. Once the car park is closed vehicles cannot be removed until the next day.
